There's not one specific path, but here's an overview of some different ways to find a career you love!

AT SCHOOL

- Select subjects and electives that complement your future
- Outdoor Ed or Outdoor Rec Electives
- Complete an Outdoor Rec VET course

TAFE / RTO

- Complete an Outdoor Rec Traineeship with employer
- Certificate III or IV in Outdoor Leadership
- Diploma in Outdoor Leadership/Recreation

UNIVERSITY

- Study a relevant field or specialisation
 e.g. Outdoor Education, Environmental Management
- Bachelors, Masters or PhD qualifications

OUTDOOR PRACTITIONER

Find a role that suits you in a camp, school or business
 Examples are: Trainee, Assistant, Support Staff, Retail worker, Outdoor Educator
 Outdoor Leader, Nature Play

SPECIALIST

Specialise in an area or activity that you enjoy
 Examples are: Specialist Guide e.g. Canyon, Alpine
 Supervisor, Trainer, Researcher, Industrial Rope Access, Emergency Services

MANAGEMENT

- Find a fulfilling role that allows you to stay in the industry for the long haul
- Examples are: Business Owner , OE School Director Lecturer, CEO
